About Lyme School of Ballet:

In 1976, after gaining her Royal Academy of Dance Registered Teacher Status (RAD RTS), Mrs. Jill Chase founded Lyme School of Ballet (LSB). Having danced and sung professionally, Mrs. Chase has a lifetime of dance, ballet and artistic experience alongside a wealth of teaching expertise and knowledge.

In 2018, Mrs. Chase retired and Miss Freya became the new Principal of LSB. Miss Freya holds a Level 4 Certificate and Level 5 Diploma in Dance Education from the RAD's Higher Education programme of the same name. She is also a Silver Swans® Licensee, allowing her to teach RAD approved classes for adults of all ages. Miss Freya gained her own RAD RTS in 2018, having successfully completed the prestigious RTS course and examination.

Miss Freya is an experienced dancer having completed all RAD Graded Ballet Examinations, from Pre-Primary to Grade 8 (Distinction), and Intermediate Foundation, Intermediate and Advanced 1 of the RAD Vocational Graded Syllabi. Miss Freya was promoted to Principal aged just 21 and feels extremely privileged to have been asked to follow in Mrs. Chase's footsteps.

LSB specialises in RAD Classical Ballet. We offer classes at a Pre-School level, following the RAD's Dance To Your Own Tune curriculum, and all RAD Graded Syllabi from Pre-Primary in Dance to Grade 8. We also offer classes for the RAD's Discovering Repertoire series, alongside all RAD Vocational Graded Pointe Work Syllabi, from Intermediate Foundation to Advanced 2. LSB gives students the opportunity to sit RAD examinations and officially celebrate and progress their achievements.

LSB also has an ever-growing family of adult ballet dancers who attend our Silver Swans® classes weekly. Silver Swans® is an RAD developed programme based on significant research into safe dance practice for the health and wellbeing of adult and older learners. As a Silver Swans Licensee, Miss Freya has undergone specialist training and is therefore professionally qualified to teach this programme.

Outside RAD related work, LSB gives students the opportunity to take part in a variety of stage performances each year, where choreography is developed specifically to stretch and challenge our dancers. In recent years, Miss Freya has choreographed a number of original works and LSB has challenged dancers to restage Classical Repertoire pieces, including 'Waltz of The Snowflakes' and the 'Dance of The Sugar Plum Fairy', both from *The Nutcracker*. We also perform in the open-air regularly, mainly as part of Lyme Regis' annual Carnival Week celebrations. Our most recent Carnival performance included a restaging of *The Sleeping Beauty's* 'Waltz of the Garlands'.

Students are welcomed to all-inclusive and friendly classes which are held mainly at The Woodmead Halls in Lyme Regis (DT7 3PG). You may wish to dance as a hobby, for exercise or more professionally in the future; whatever your reasons, all ages and abilities are catered for at Lyme School of Ballet.
